Scholarship Application

A number of \$500 to \$2,000 scholarships are being made available through the Bobby Stephen Fund for Education to applicants in need of support to further their educational endeavors due to financial circumstances. In order to apply for one of these scholarships, applicants must complete this application and have been accepted at a college, university, community college, technical school, or enrolled in a certificate program for the upcoming school year.

If you have been accepted into a certificate program or a two-year or four-year degree program, you must show that ***you have substantial financial need and meet at least one of the first three criteria:***

1. You must be of senior status in high school and accepted at an institution of higher learning or in a certificate program.
2. A student attending a certificate program or institution of higher learning.
3. A single parent accepted to or attending a certificate program or institution of higher learning.

As well as:

4. Complete this application. ***Applications must be submitted by April 15.***
5. Write a one-page essay (****see Essay Topic below***).
6. Provide at least one reference letter from someone other than a family member.
7. Attach a copy of your completed FAFSA form.

***Essay Topic:** What would this scholarship mean to you personally and why do you feel it is important for you to continue your education?
